The Mobile Percussion Seminar is designed to develop the mental and physical aspects of percussion performance and leadership skills. Students will have a chance to work with Thom Hannum and his staff of specialists in the areas of marching percussion and mallet percussion.

Thom Hannum, a Drum Corps International Hall of Fame member, is the Associate Band Director for the University of Massachusetts Amherst Minuteman Marching Band and Director of the Marimba Ensembles program. Thom is a world renowned percussion clinician and teacher and has worked with the Cadets, the Star of Indiana and the Tony Award winning production Blast! Thom is currently the percussion arranger for Carolina Crown.

From beginner to advanced skill levels, Thom's new book *A Percussionist's Guide to Check Patterns*, is designed to help percussionists at any level perfect their craft.

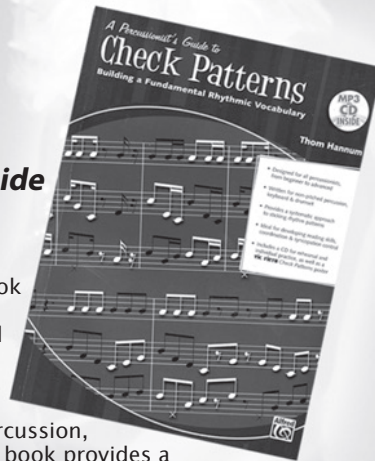
